The Clyde Scholarship will provide a \$1000.00 award to a deserving male or female student that is planning to obtain an **undergraduate or post-graduate degree** in intelligence-related studies.

The student must be an American Citizen.

The deadline for applications is July 1 of each year. The winner will be announced on August 15.

There will be one winner per year. Students may reapply the following year.
